### What is it?

A searchable collection of thousands of books and videos about “computer stuff”. Many of them are the well known animal-themed books published by O’Reilly. Safari Technical Books can help computer users at a variety of skill levels -- from “dummies” to “whiz kids” -- to solve problems and learn about such topics as : office software, digital media, information technology and software development, network administration, project management and more.

### How do I use it?

- Make sure you are in the STSci domain, or use the proxy server or VPN.
- You don’t need an account, but you have the option to create one to make use of personalization/customization features.

### How can I find out about new books?

Safari Technical Books has a handy RSS feed to alert you to new titles. Safari also offers a Customer Newsletter (<http://safaribooksonline.com/newsletter/0511/>)

### What are some restrictions on use?

- STSci currently subscribes to two simultaneous users. If you are unable to get in, try again shortly.
- Due to copyright restrictions, you can only email or print at the page level (not the chapter or section level), one page at a time. Systematic printing and downloading are not allowed.
