LibX at STSci


What is LibX?

- LibX is a Firefox plug-in that directly connects you to STSci's print and electronic collections quickly and easily from within a web-browser.
- LibX searches our Library Catalog and E-Journal Portal for references to information found on Amazon.com, other library catalogs, citations found in journal articles, the ADS, and any other resource that allows you to highlight and drag text.

How do I install it?

How do I use it?

- Highlight a title, keywords or author with your mouse. "Right click" and select "Search Space Telescope Science Institute" from the menu selections.
- Alternatively, Highlight a journal title. "Right click" and select "Search STSci E Journal Portal" from the menu selections.
- Text may be highlighted and dragged to the upper right hand corner of your browser where it says "Search ILink..."
- Directly search the Library Catalog or E Journal Portal using the box at the top of your browser (right underneath the URL window.)
- Click on the  when you see it on a webpage.
