Subject: Moving GTO time

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Tony,

I have finished playing musical chairs with the TNO GTO programs and would like to request the following time be transferred between programs:

1. Parker (JWST 1254) transfer 0.43 hours to Hines (JWST 1272)
2. Parker (JWST 1254) transfer 0.50 hours to Lunine (JWST 1273)
3. Parker (JWST 1254) transfer 0.97 hours to Stansberry (JWST 1191)

Removing one Makemake MIRI imaging observation from Alex Parker's program made up for the overruns in Dean Hines' and John Stansberry's programs (due to updates to the timing model in APT). The remainder of the savings in Alex's program are being moved to Jonathan Lunine's program to boost the total time for some of the Centaurs in the program. We can evaluate whether we would like to use that time instead to add a whole new Centaur (or another object) to the program following the release of the Cycle 1 results in the summer. But for now we need to account for the time somehow or lose it.
