ABSTRACT

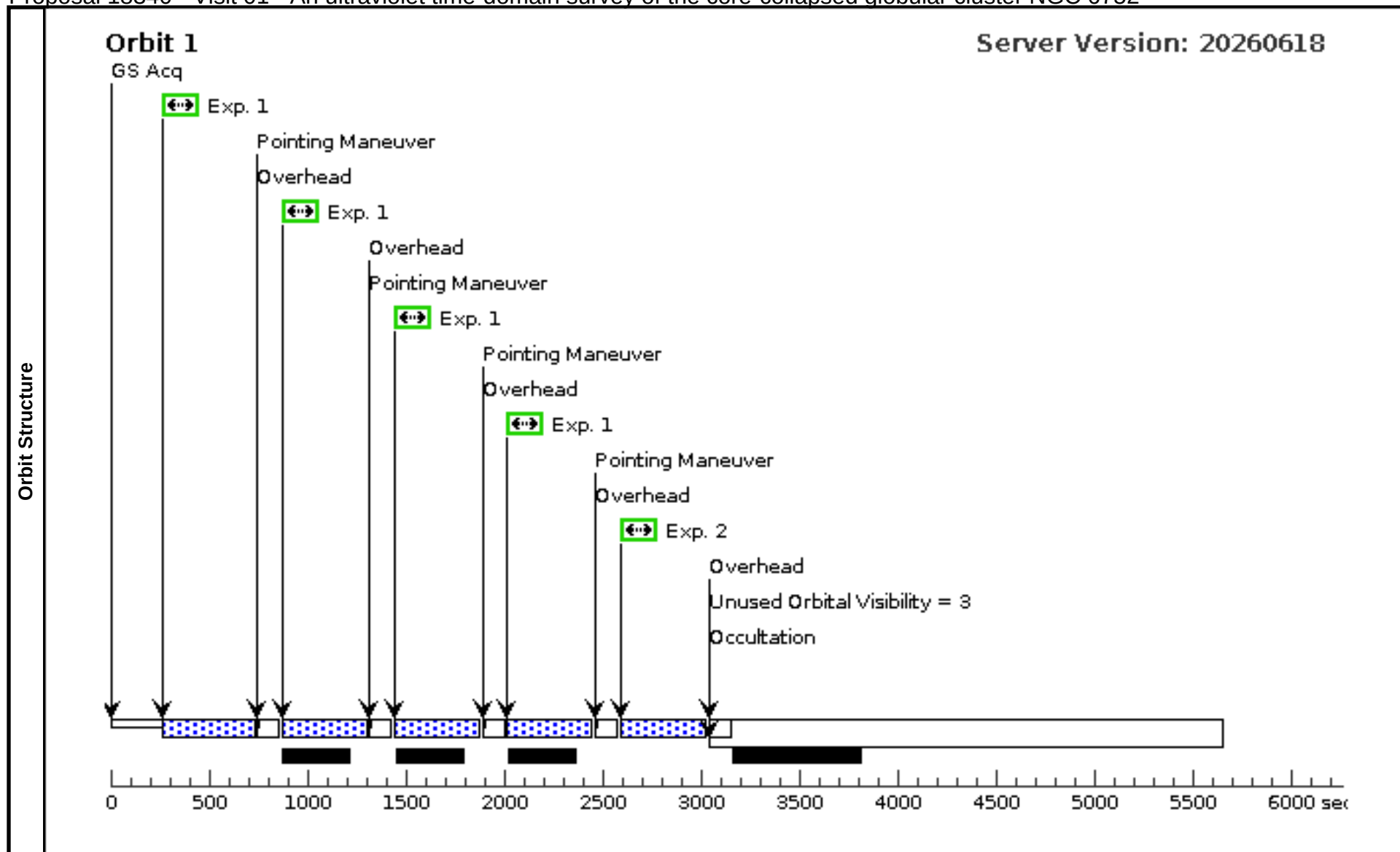
Compact binaries are responsible for many of the most extreme phenomena in the universe, including X-ray binaries, millisecond pulsars, and gravitational waves (GW), but significant questions remain on their formation and evolution. N-body simulations have found that globular clusters---particularly those that are core-collapsed---should be prolific factories of binaries due to high rates of dynamical interactions, yet observational evidence remains sparse due to the difficulty of probing their dense cores from the ground. We propose an ultraviolet time-domain survey of the nearby, massive, core-collapsed globular cluster NGC 6752 to characterize its compact binary population. Using periodicity searches on light curves produced from these observations, we will uncover multi-messenger sources observable by LISA, shed light on the dynamical histories of GWs detected by LIGO-Virgo-KAGRA, and characterize the wealth of X-ray sources and millisecond pulsars in NGC 6752. These observations will provide insight into the dynamical interaction of objects in dense stellar environments, opening up a new window into our understanding of binary evolution.

OBSERVING DESCRIPTION

We will use WFC3/UVIS with the F300X filter to perform a UV time-domain survey of the core-collapsed globular cluster NGC 6752. Each orbit is composed of five 436 sec exposures using the WFC3-UVIS-DITHER-BOX pattern for four of the exposures. Each exposure also has an 18e flash applied. To maximize the observing baseline, we split the 40 orbits into four 10-orbit blocks, with timing requirements to spread out each block throughout Cycle 34.

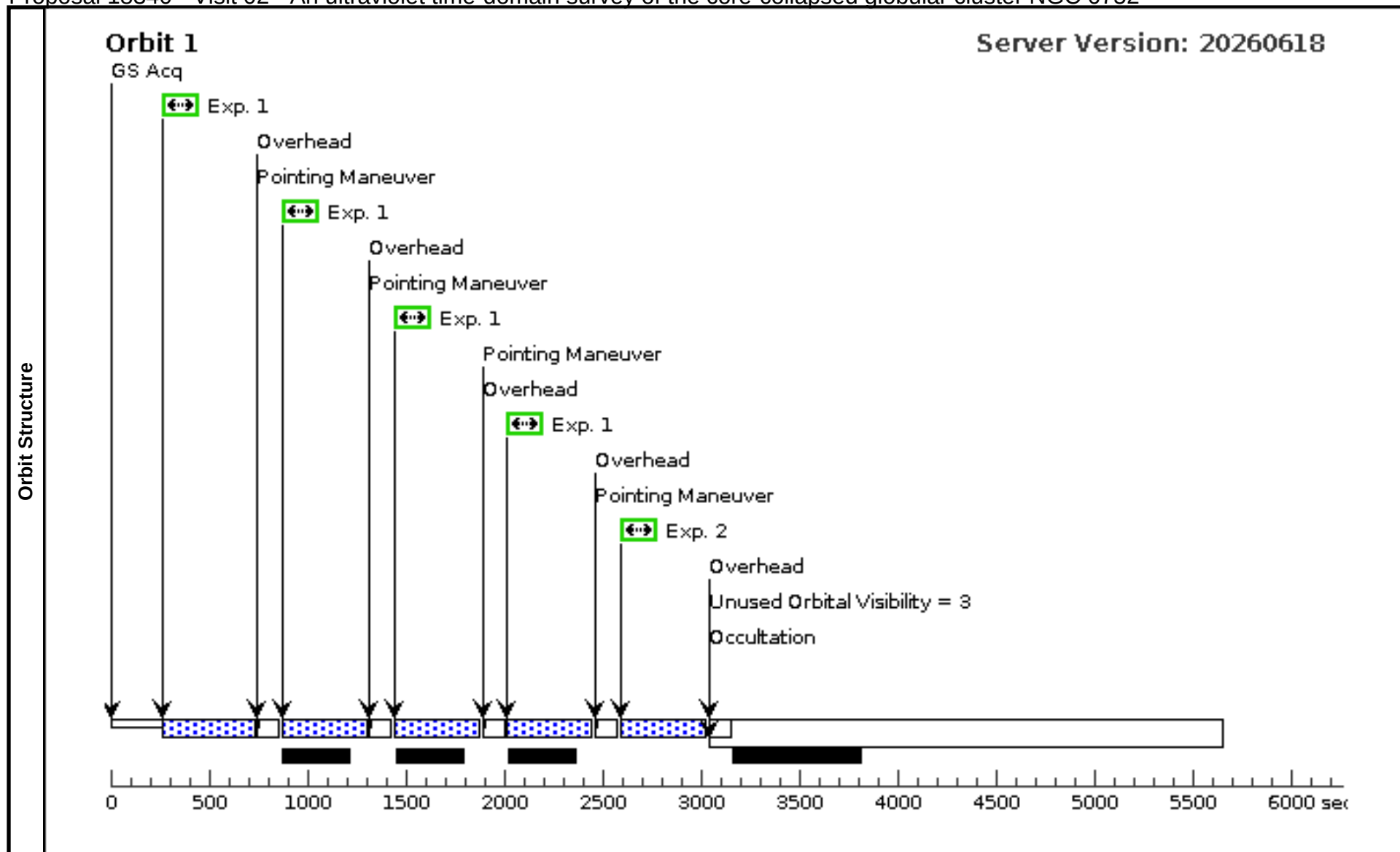
